BRAVO is a professional organization based and focused on knowledge, entrepreneurship, civil society development, non-formal education and innovative learning and development techniques for young people and adults. What makes our organization outstanding and ready to take responsibility are the key principles we nurture, celebrate and act upon: <b>tolerance, democracy, diversity, voluntariness and openness.</b></p> <p>By fostering partnerships between the private, public, and civil society sectors, BRAVO is in a strong position to influence and contribute to long-term local community development, particularly by enabling youth to gain the skills required</p>

in the twenty-first century, fostering more accessible, offering, and inclusive non-formal education, and making investments in innovations and entrepreneurship.

Our primary target group is young people aged 15 to 35, however as can be seen from the above - BRAVO focuses on all persons in need of assistance and support.
